Relative to standing in solidarity with Jewish communities, supporting the people of Israel, and condemning the horrendous attack and war crimes of Hamas that occurred in October 2023.

BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'TRENTAL SIETTE NA LIHESLATURAN **GUÅHAN:** 2

WHEREAS, on October 7, 2023, Gaza militants known as the terrorist organization, Hamas, launched a coordinated assault on southern Israel. The Jewish nation state was bombarded with thousands of rockets and armed fighters. Countless innocent lives were taken with force, brutality, and ruthlessness; and

WHEREAS, the assault coincided with the Jewish Sabbath and religious holiday recognizing the 50th anniversary of the 1973 Yom Kipper War that pitted Israel against Egypt and Syria. The timing, among other factors, caught Israel off guard, who was subsequently overwhelmed by the organized efforts of the Islamic militant group to weaken their defense. Citizens saw legions of missiles shoot from Gaza and target them, filling the sky with rockets and explosions, with some succeeding in evading the anti-missile system, and impacting Israeli land; and

WHEREAS, in addition to bombarding the Iron Dome, Israel's modern air defense system, with thousands of rockets, the militants invaded Israel by land, sea, and air, via paragliders; and

WHEREAS, the first of victims in the Islamic militia's campaign of violence and destruction included more than 260 attendees of a music festival held near the Gaza border. The festival-goers were ambushed as the armed militants slaughtered as many as they could and took the remaining survivors as hostages; and

WHEREAS, the bloodshed continued with armed militants invading the villages nearest to the Gaza border, killing and harming as many as they could, leaving death and devastation in their wake; and

WHEREAS, the scale of brutality Hamas inflicted on Israel is unparalleled in modern warfare and has opened a new chapter of terrorism as well as conflicts in the middle east. The Hamas insurgents ruthlessly seek to annihilate the people of Israel, inflicting pain and terror on any Israeli that they encounter, every minute of every day that passes; and

WHEREAS, the rest of the world watched in horror as the harrowing events unfolded, via news networks, but most notably through social media channels. The terrorist group documented and shared the crimes they committed with pride and no remorse. It was abundantly clear that the militants made no distinction and treated everyone with equal hate and disgust. Spread through social platforms, the world saw disturbing, graphic videos and pictures of atrocities being done to the Israelis, including kidnapping, brutalizing, and killing men, women, and children; and

WHEREAS, the Israeli Prime Minister, Benjamin Netanyahu declared war on Hamas, and ordered a "complete siege" of Gaza, initiating military operations to cut off the supply of electricity, food, water, and fuel, effectively destabilizing and crippling the Palestinian enclave; and

1	WHEREAS, the retaliation of Israel also concentrated on airstrikes that reduced
2	buildings and homes to rubble, obliterating the Gaza skyline. In light of the scores of
3	Israelis that have died and the unknown number of hostages taken, an Israeli invasion
4	is inevitable. Israeli Prime Minister Netanyahu stated "We will bring the fight to them
5	with a might and scale that the enemy has not yet known."; and
6	WHEREAS, following the militaristic reprisal of the Israeli Defense Force, a
7	spokesperson for Hamas stated that the militant group would "begin killing civilian
8	hostages and broadcasting the acts committed."; and
9	WHEREAS, the death toll continues to rise, exceeding 1200 Israelis and 900
10	Gaza Palestinians. Casualties have suffered on both sides, with innocents being the most
11	affected. Among the casualties are non-Israeli citizens, including but not limited to,
12	American, Thai, Nepali, Ukrainian, French, Philippine, and British victims; and
13	WHEREAS,. Hamas has sworn to destroy Israel, carrying out numerous suicide
14	bombings and other deadly attacks against Israeli soldiers and civilians. The Islamist
15	militant group and one of two Palestinian political parties, was founded in 1987, with
16	roots and ties to the Muslim Brotherhood, and designated by the U.S. as a terrorist group
17	in 1997; and
18	WHEREAS, Israel is an ally of the United States. Unified by strong historic ties
19	as well as a shared commitment to democracy, economic prosperity, and regional
20	security, the relationship between Israel and the United States is a mutually beneficial
21	one; and
22	WHEREAS, President Joe Biden has vowed U.S. support for Israel by
23	condemning the Hamas attack, stating it is "an act of sheer evil," and further reaffirming
24	the position of America by saying, "We stand with Israel." In the face of the attacks,
25	the 46th President of the United States took action and authorized an aircraft carrier to
26	move closer to Israel; and
27	WHEREAS, Guam joins the rest of world as witnesses to the horror and
28	casualties of war and rallies behind the nation of Israel; and

1	WHEREAS, I Liheslaturan Guåhan believes in protecting human rights,
2	promoting peace, and advocating on behalf of the vulnerable and defenseless. No man,
3	woman, or child should have to suffer and endure the carnage of that which is befalling
4	the citizens of Israel and the victims also present at the time of the attack; now therefore,
5	be it
6	RESOLVED, that I Mina'trentai Siette Na Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby,
7	on behalf of the people of Guam, stand in solidarity with the affected Jewish
8	communities, support the nation of Israel, and condemn the horrendous attack and war
9	crimes of Hamas that occurred in October 2023; and be it further
10	RESOLVED, that the Speaker certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the
11	adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to the Honorable
12	Anthony Blinken, U.S. Secretary of State; to the Honorable Michael Herzog, Israeli
13	Ambassador to the United States; to the Honorable Benjamin Netanyahu, Prime
14	Minister of Israel; to the Honorable James C. Moylan, Guam's Delegate to Congress;
15	and to the Honorable Lourdes A. Leon Guerrero, I Maga'hågan Guåhan.
